- D1 **Adult Leader for Velocity:** Being an Adult Leader means you are there to help with all of the activities that go on at Velocity and as a back-up for Morgan. The Jr. High students meet on Sundays from 6-7:45 PM. The Sr. High students meet Sundays from 6:45-8:30 PM. The more volunteers the more flexibility in each volunteers' schedule.
- D2 **Transportation for Youth:** Transport the youth in your personal car or the church van to various events.
- D3 **Youth Sunday School Teacher:** Teach either the junior high or senior high Sunday School class on a quarterly basis or shorter if need be. We need at least four volunteers.
- D4 **Substitute Youth Sunday School Teacher:** Help as needed with the junior or senior high Sunday School class.
- D5 **South District Summer Camp Counselor:** Come spend one week in July, July 4-8, 2011 at Lakeview (www.lakeviewmcc.org). This week is jam-packed with fun and worship.
